

GREAT SHELFORD PARISH COUNCIL

Minutes of Parish Council Highways Sub-Committee Meeting held in the Pavilion
Woollards Lane, Great Shelford at 1930 on 6 January 2016.

Present: Cllrs Nettleton (chair), Nightingale, Coggins, Ashurst. **Apologies** from Cllrs Talbott and Milson. **Also present** about 30 members of the public. There were no **Declarations of Interest**.

The meeting was called specifically to discuss and make a decision on what measures needed to be taken in response to issues with the 30mph speed limit in Hinton Way.

1. PUBLIC SESSION:

There was a lively discussion on the 30mph limit, with strong views being presented both in favour of keeping the 30mph limit and reverting to 40mph at the top end of Hinton Way.

2. DECISIONS

It was unanimously agreed by the councillors present that:

- The 30mph limit be retained.
- The parish council would fund one flashing speed indicator board at a cost of approximately £4,000. This would probably be located on the LHS outbound from the village just before the brow of the hill. Cllr Nettleton will seek feedback from residents regarding the precise location.
- The parish council would fund one 30mph roundel to be painted on the road between the 30mph limit signs at Shelford Bottom and the first
- The parish council would look at the possibility of installing a ‘Shelford welcomes careful drivers’ sign. Cllr Nightingale to obtain costs.

There being no other business, the Chairman closed the meeting at 2030.
